Uniform Dress Code Policy

Ecole Francaise students are expected to adhere to the following uniform dress code. Students must purchase their clothing from a uniform shop. All items of apparel permitted under our dress code are available from:

- *Pants, walking shorts, skorts, and skirts must be solid navy blue or khaki.
Girls may also wear the designated plaid jumper, walking shorts, skorts and skirts.
(Solid navy or tan jumpers are not approved for wear)
- * Belts must be worn with pants or shorts. (Preschool students are exempt)
- * Polo shirts & turtlenecks must be solid, white, light blue, navy, or hunter green. (All shirts must have collars)
- * Oxford shirts and uniform blouses may be light blue or white.
- * Sweater vests (V neck) and sweaters (V neck, crew neck, or cardigan) must be navy or hunter green.
- * Shirts and blouses must be tucked in at all times.
- *The *only* sweatshirts permissible are official Ecole embroidered sweatshirts (Available only through the School Closet, Ltd or School Days.) or **Ecole logowear.**
- ***Shoes must have smooth non-marking soles.**
Many athletic shoes will not meet this criterion.
(Open-toed shoes and sandals are not permitted at school.)
- * Accessories: hair ribbons, barrettes, headbands, belts, socks, tights, must coordinate in color with uniform/ dress code attire. (No *pink or purple*) The wearing of jewelry should be limited.
- * Students should present a natural appearance. *No make-up, lipstick, wigs or hairpieces are permitted.*
- Hats and/or jackets may not be worn inside at any time.

***Each student is to have one Official Uniform consisting of:**
Khaki pants, shorts, skirts or skorts and hunter green polo, either long or short sleeved.
This uniform is to be worn on all field trips, assembly days, and other "special occasions" as directed by the school.

Students are expected to follow the dress code policy when on campus before, during or after school, unless otherwise noted by the school in writing. During other school related functions and activities children may be out of dress code as long as their attire is appropriate.

Any other issues that may pertain to the uniform dress code will be determined by the administration.
