Ecole Francaise Summer Program Agreement

1. Students not enrolled at Ecole Francaise during the academic year are required to pay a non-refundable \$35.00 registration fee at the time of registration in order to secure placement in the summer program.
2. Registrations will be accepted until classes are filled.
Registration by April 1, 2010 guarantees a position.
Registration by May 15th is encouraged.
3. Fees for each week are due the first day of that week. After this date a late fee of \$20.00 will be assessed.
4. Special class fees are due prior to the beginning of the special class.
5. School policy requires that all payments be made by check or money order made payable to Education Unlimited. Checks returned due to insufficient funds will be assessed a \$20.00 NSF fee and must be replaced with a money order. CASH & CREDIT CARDS WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED.
6. All students are to be provided with lunch and a beverage on a daily basis. If you choose to participate in the contracted catering service, lunches must be ordered and paid through the caterer. Children remaining after 3:00pm should also be provided with a snack and beverage.
7. If a student is not picked up by their program's designated pick-up time, (noon, 3:00 or 6:00); a late fee of \$7.00 per fifteen minutes or fraction thereof will be assessed.
8. No care will be provided for children who do not participate in scheduled field trips.
9. Education Unlimited serves children who are able to function successfully in a group setting. If, in the judgment of the professional staff, a child is not able to function in the group setting, or the program is not able to meet the needs of a particular child, the family may be asked to withdraw the child from the program.
